### II. CORPORATE BACKGROUND:

UNDP works in about 170 countries and territories, helping to eradicate poverty, reduce inequalities and exclusion, and build resilience so countries can sustain progress. As the UN's development agency, UNDP plays a critical role in helping countries achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.

### III. FELLOWSHIP OFFICE BACKGROUND:

United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in China is the China country office of the United Nations Development Programme – the global development network of the United Nations. UNDP has been working in China over the past 40 years, partnering to advance various phases of China's development. We provide development advisory services and implement projects through innovation and applying our international experience and network in three pillars: supporting China's transformation to a low-carbon economy so that more people enjoy a cleaner, healthier environment; facilitating China's shift to using the SDGs as a standard for its inclusive development, economic decisions and investments, and supporting China's international cooperation and south-south engagement for SDG attainment.

The Fellowship Programme, in collaboration with partners, marks the first step in the SDG Fellowships Accelerating Sustainable Transformation Initiative (SDG FAST). It is designed to develop a pipeline of talented young professionals who are engaged and supporting to accelerate the SDGs and national development priorities in China. The fellows will also have the opportunity to gain access to extensive learning resources, including relevant practical knowledge, corporate learning materials, domestic and international working experiences, under the mentorship and supervision of professionals in UNDP China.

Under the Planet Pillar of UNDP China, the Ecosystem and Biodiversity portfolio, in alignment with the UN Convention on Biological Diversity, collaborate with central and local governments across more than 20 provinces to safeguard China's rich biodiversity and critical ecosystems.

Our work encompasses a wide range of conservation initiatives, from wetland protection to wildlife preservation. We strengthen China's ecological governance by providing technical assistance, sharing international best practices, and informing policy and legal reforms. Furthermore, we drive on-the-ground impact through capacity-building, public awareness campaigns, and the demonstration of pilot projects.

**Fellowship Scope:** Under the guidance and direct supervision of the Programme & Risk Management Analyst of Pillar II, the Fellow will provide effective support: a) on the financial and operational management of the

Ecosystem and Biodiversity (EBD) Portfolio in Quantum system/GSSC platform; and b) on quality assurance and risk management of projects under EBD portfolio. Besides the ongoing projects, he/she will also provide support when delegated on formulation of pipelines in the areas of biodiversity conservation. This will involve supporting scoping research into key current issues on the topics and support to development of reports and publications to increase UNDP advocacy and visibility on such issues. Through working in close collaboration with members of the Pillar II (Planet) Team at UNDP, the fellow will have plenty of opportunities to learn about UNDP's role in supporting partners in China in the areas of ecosystem and environment, and will be exposed to practices and experiences with key cooperation partners through the implementation of programmes.
